## SCC Seeks New Tournament Site

After a 6-year run at the Signature Inn, the SCC will be seeking new quarters for its chess tournaments beginning next year. The Signature Inn has been reliable, spacious, quiet, and well-lit, but those benefits came at a high price, at the expense of the tournament's prize funds.

Management has informed us that the rental on that room will go even higher at the turn of the year, placing it out of our reach if we do not wish to jeopardize our newfound turnout with yet more prize fund cuts. So, we are currently seeking a new place to hold our tournaments. The December 8 tournament will be our last at the Signature Inn.

If we can find a place that's cheaper, we may even be able to raise the prize fund or, failing that, lower the number of people required for a 100% payout! We have postponed drawing up next year's tournament schedule until we have a place to hold them.
