Many Three-Way Ties at February Tourney

Thirty-one chess players came to the union hall on February 5 to play in the club's first tournament of 2011. Three of them ended the day with $3\frac{1}{2}$ points, and tied for first, second, and the A-B prize. These were Matt Cremeens, of Springfield; Pete Karagianis, of Bloomington; and Rodney Vaughn, of Kentucky. First place in the Class C-D category was also split three ways, between Thomas Knoedler, of Springfield; Chase Walbert, of Bloomington; and Andrew Fei, of Peoria. They each scored 3 points.

Once again, there were enough entries to allow the creation of second place prizes in the A-B and C-D sections. Besides increasing the prizes of the three C-D winners, this also gave prizes to Brian Villarreal, of Streator; Bruce Michel, of Stonington; and Ian Gilchrist, of Marion. They also scored 3 points.

A fourth three-way tie existed in the Class E section, where Kent Frantz, of Bloomington; Charles Coffman, of Naperville; and Kyle Mayhugh, of Hannibal, Mo. Each scored 2 points. The first unrated player, Logan Winders, of Springfield, scored 1 point and was the only one to win his section outright.
