## Club Launches Scholastic Program

During its business meeting on November 18, the club started a pilot scholastic program by creating the position of Scholastic Director, and appointing Leonard Ferguson to be its first officer. Besides offering lessons, Leonard would like to organize a scholastic tournament in Springfield some time in the coming months, although this remains in the early planning stages as of press time. Other events may be added at a later time. For more information, see Leonard.

The club is now offering **scholastic memberships** for those enrolled in primary or secondary school. Scholastic memberships cost \$5 per year, and come with all benefits of club membership, except that scholastic members are not entitled to a vote at club business meetings. Scholastic memberships expire on June 30. First-time scholastic members may pro-rate their first year's dues based on the number of months remaining in the current or upcoming academic year, defined as September through June, rounded up to the next whole dollar.

Those who were *club members in 2015* and are *eligible for scholastic membership* may **convert their membership** to Scholastic and *extend it to June 30, 2016 at no charge*. This is a *one-time option* and must be exercised by January 31, 2016. See membership form on page 2.

The Springfield Evening Kiwanis club has folded, so their annual scholastic tournament will not be held this year unless another organization can take over.

## New Club Officers Seated

At our club business meeting on November 18, we took nominations for club offices for the coming year.
