SCC celebrates National Chess Day

13 chess players celebrated National Chess Day with the SCC at Douglas United Methodist Church on October 14. Bernard Parham, of Lafayette, Ind., scored a perfect 4-0 sweep to take first place, while second place (along with portions of the class prizes) went to Evan Gresen and Thomas Knoedler, both of Springfield. They each scored 3 points.

The remainder of the Class A-B prize went to Sadkrith Malladi, of Bloomington, while the rest of the Class C-D prize devolved to Jimmie Cecil and John Leahy, both of Springfield, and Spencer Vincent, of Normal. All of the above scored 2 points. Jared Dong and Girish Villa, both of Springfield, won the Class E and unrated prizes respectively, each with 1 point.

Somewhat unusually, every game in this tournament was decisive; there were no draws! Complete results are on page 2.
