SCC celebrates National Chess Day

On October 13, National Chess Day, 22 players participated in the SCC's tournament at Douglas United Methodist Church. Greg Whitlock, of Champaign, defeated all four opponents for a 4-0 sweep and first place, while second place went to Jim Larson, of Springfield, with 3½ points. Evan Gresen, of Springfield; Mark Walters, of Champaign; and Quinn Higginbotham, of Bloomington, each scored 3 points and won the Class A-B, C-D, and E prizes respectively. Finally, Jiya Singla, of Springfield, scored 1 point and won first unrated.

Somewhat unusually, every prize had exactly one clear winner; there were no ties or splits! Complete results are on page 2.
