Maddox Todd Wins First Tournament

The club's first full-day tournament of 2025 was held on March 29, and it drew 33 chess players. In his first tournament, Maddox Todd swept with a perfect 4-0 score and took first place, just ahead of James Healy, who had 3½ out of 4.

Jimmie Cecil and Jeffrey Smith scored 3 points and tied for first in Class B-C, while Marshall Bigler, Sean Pepper, and Andres Maldonado shared first in Class D-E, also scoring 3 points. Jon Ommen and Kirk Brackenhoff each had 2 points and split first in Class F and below.

Three unrated players had 2 points and shared first in that division, these were Sawyer Casey, Anthony Romero, and Kenadi Malone. In addition, the club would like to recognize six other players for their first tournament: Brian Wilson, Kesava Gattu, Audrey Odenkirk, Arjun Patel, Namiesh Songa, and Ronit Sukthanker. Jimmie Cecil's 2025 survey of Springfield area chess players produced these (abridged) results:

- A plurality learned about the club from our internet site; other methods mentioned included the club's Facebook page, chess.com page, and word of mouth.
- About 2 in 5 respondents were members of the club.
- Slightly less than 2 in 5 respondents attend club meetings at least twice monthly.
- 3 in 4 respondents found the meetings conveniently scheduled.
- Saturday afternoons were the most commonly requested alternative; we will keep this in mind when secondary monthly meetings are restarted.
- Most respondents are members of the USCF and expressed interest in tournaments.
- Friendship and socialization, and improving one's chess, were the strongest draws.
- Suggested club activities included lectures, lessons, simul, more tournaments, outdoor events, and a club picnic.
